Latest statistics show that the evangelical Church has a connection with just 2% of millennials in the nation. A generation of young people has grown up in Scotland with no connection to the Church or the values of the gospel that are essential for the nation to flourish.

As Christians, our voices and values are being moved from the centre to the margins. <u>How many Christians do we have in our nation that are in positions of influence and authority in the public sphere?</u>

There is a desperate need for more Nehemiahs: Christian leaders who can live out and articulate Christian values in society.

If ever there was a time to invest in a new generation of Scottish Christian leaders in public life, then surely it is now. But we need your help to do this.

Imagine a generation of young, gifted followers of Jesus who feel called to serve as leaders in business, media, politics, education – disciples who know one another, pray for each other and serve God by making the nation a better place for all those who live here.

What would it take to create such a generation?

We are convinced that God is calling the Evangelical Alliance in Scotland to lead the way in creating, supporting and nurturing this generation of public leaders. But to do this, we need your support.

This is not a quick fix. It is about building relationships and learning from those who have gone before. It requires a long-term strategy to build a generation of Christians of national and spiritual influence, a generation of culture-changers — a generation of Nehemiahs.
