Tom is an emerging business leader, trying to lead with integrity as he travels globally to negotiate multi-million pound deals. Shona is a TV producer who is learning how to live in the media world and tell good news stories with honesty, and Emily is a children's author with a passion for writing stories of hope that influence and inspire.
