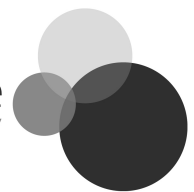

Edited by David Hilborn, £12.50 (Published in 2004 by Paternoster Press).

Encouraging Alliance members to take their place at the heart of a *movement for change* in contemporary Britain by looking back at the many constructive contributions to the transformation of society made by British evangelicals in recent history.

Faith, Health and Prosperity

Edited by Andrew Perriman, £8.99 (Published in 2003 by Paternoster Press).

The Word of Faith movement is one of the most controversial forms of modern Christianity. It has been accused of distorting Scripture and exporting the worst of American tele-evangelism around the world. This book acknowledges the movement's shortcomings but takes historical, religious and cultural circumstances into account. Subsequently it offers a ground for mutual understanding and a biblical analysis on prosperity.

God and the Generations

Edited by David Hilborn & Matt Bird, £9.99 (Published in 2002 by Paternoster Press).

Divisions between different generations are much discussed in western Christianity today. Church growth theorists, evangelists and missiologists increasingly segment communities and congregations into defined groups. This report highlights the relevance of such generation-based analysis for contemporary Christian life, but also offers a constructive critique of existing work in the field.

One body in Christ

Ian Randall & David Hilborn, £14.99 (Published in 2001 by Paternoster Press).

Did you know that the Alliance initially turned Billy Graham down when he asked it to sponsor his 1966 London crusade? This and other historical facts about the Alliance and its role in the British Church since 1846 are included in this book.

Evangelicalism and the Orthodox Church

An ACUTE report, £7.99 (Published in 2001 by Paternoster Press).

Given the awakening evangelical interest in other forms of Christian spirituality, this book lays the groundwork for building stronger relationships between evangelical and Orthodox believers.

'Toronto' in perspective

Edited by David Hilborn, £19.99 (Published in 2001 by Paternoster Press).

Six prominent evangelical scholars and writers offer their reflections on the controversial 'Toronto Blessing' seven years after it exploded onto the church scene. Includes an introduction and conclusion reflecting the Evangelical Alliance's perspective on this and other charismatic phenomena.

Nature of Hell

An ACUTE report, £7.99 (Published in 2000 by Paternoster Press).

Evangelicals have traditionally held the view that unbelievers will be condemned without exception, but increasing numbers are declaring sympathy for conditional immortality. This report tackles this and other related issues and is both biblical and pastoral.

Faith, Hope & Homosexuality

An ACUTE report, £4.99 (Published in 1998 by Paternoster Press).

Presenting a clear outline of the orthodox Christian view of homosexual behaviour, this book offers a positive contribution to the ongoing debate. Helpful to those wishing to understand biblical material on homosexuality and those involved with pastoral work.
