- To resource and support churches in liaison with the unity and mission teams.
- To promote Christian public leadership development in Wales.

Main tasks and responsibilities:

- Increase the membership of the Evangelical Alliance among churches, organisations and individuals through mission resources, events and communications.
- Liaise with the heads of mission and unity to ensure the Evangelical Alliance is effectively resourcing the church in Wales for mission.
- Assist in the development and delivery of communication strategies for church engagement in Wales.
- Assist in the delivery and marketing of our resources, liaising with the wider staff team and producing content; networking and relationship building as necessary.
- Promote the Public Leadership programme and support engagement in Wales in liaison with the Public Leadership UK lead.
- Develop and support the Wales Public Leader steering group and local volunteer champions.
- Contribute to development and strategic planning discussions for the Public Leadership programme in Wales.
- Oversee the day-to-day management of the Public Leadership alumni network in Wales in liaison with the Public Leadership UK lead.
- To undertake other duties as directed by the head of Evangelical Alliance in Wales.

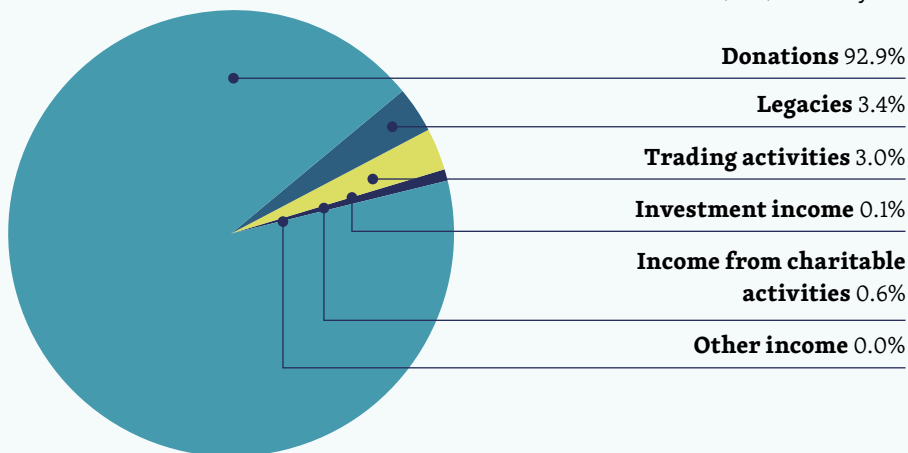

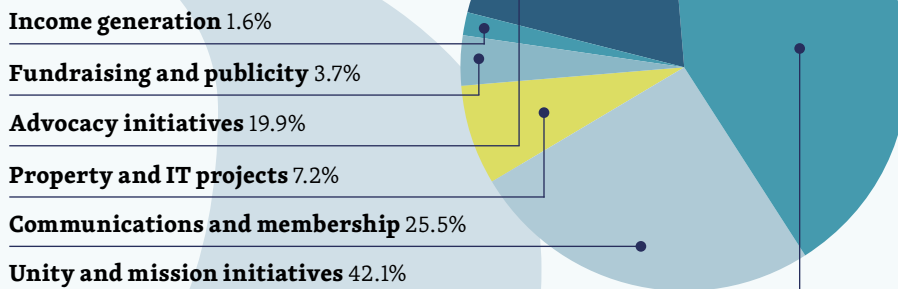
Income £2,518,612

Y Cynghairir Efengylaidd ydy'r corff mwyaf a'r hynaf sy'n gwasanaethu Cristnogion efengylaidd yn y DU. Ers 1846, rydyn ni wedi bod yn uno Cristnogion a sicrhau llais iddyn nhw yng nghoridorau grym. Rydyn ni hefyd wedi bod yn arfogi eglwysi ar gyfer cenhadaeth: yn eu hysbrydoli i yrru trawsnewidiad ysbrydol, cymdeithasol a chorfforol eu cymunedau.

Yn Ioan 17 – gweddi olaf Iesu – mae Crist yn gweddïo fel hyn: “Fi ynddyn nhw a ti ynof fi. Dw i am iddyn nhw gael eu dwyn i undod llawn, i'r byd gael gwybod mai ti sydd wedi fy anfon i, a dy fod ti wedi'u caru nhw yn union fel rwyf wedi fy ngharu i.” Rydyn ni'n credu bod yr undod hwnnw a weddiodd Iesu yn cael ei adlewyrchu trwy i'r eglwys ddod ynghyd, gosod o'r neilltu gwahaniaethau enwadol, a chydweithio dros yr efengyl.

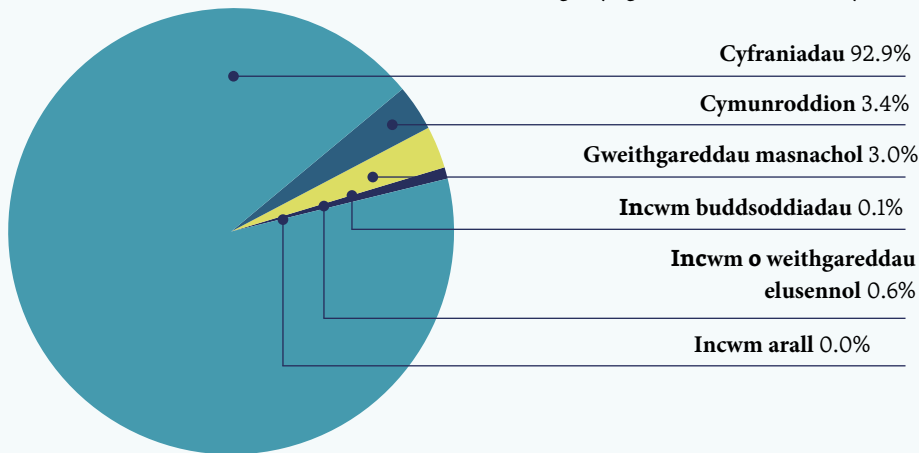

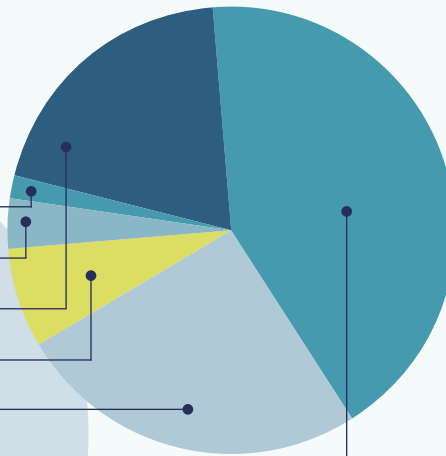

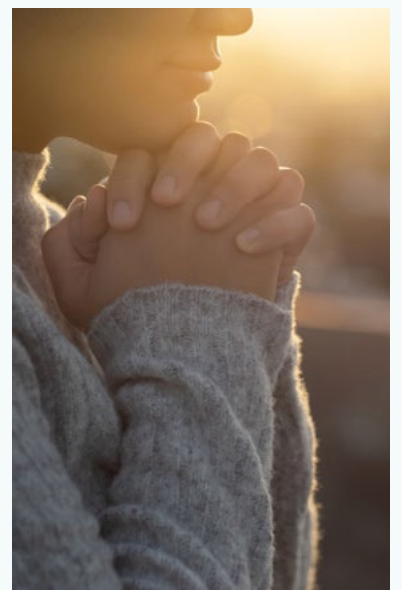
