May 25, 2014:	European Election 2014 results announced
May/June, 2014:	Cabinet reshuffle is expected
June 4, 2014:	State opening of Parliament and the Queen's speech which will set the legislative agenda for the rest of this Parliamentary term
September 18, 2014:	Scottish independence referendum
September 21, 2014:	Labour Party's autumn conference opens in Manchester
September 28, 2014:	Conservative Party's autumn conference opens in Birmingham
October 4, 2014:	Liberal Democrat's autumn conference opens in Glasgow
October 28, 2014:	Third quarter GDP figures are expected to confirm Britain's economy is back to pre-recession levels
December 4, 2014:	Autumn Statement
March 18, 2015:	Budget
March 30, 2015:	Parliament dissolved before the General Election
April, 2015:	Tax changes take effect including corporate tax reducing from 21% to 20%
May 7, 2015:	General Election
